- Provide a copy of their high school diploma/GED.
- Provide proof of required immunizations.

This course is being taught in conjunction with a Firefighter Recruit Class. As a part of the EMT class, students will complete a fire certified EVD class (20 hours), and a Traffic Incident Management Safety class (4 hours). Proof of previous certification will be accepted.
